



## FEE SCHEDULE

The tuition for students in grades K-5 during the 2010-2011 school year is \$3050.00. In addition, there is a \$75 application fee due with the submission of your child's application (new students only) and a \$325 book fee due at the time of enrollment.

The tuition fee may be paid in its entirety by September 1. If the full amount can not be paid at one time, the following payment plans are available:

### 12-month plan

Beginning in May, 2010, \$254.00 is due at the first of the month. The first installation would be due on or before May 1, 2010. The final payment shall be made on or before April 1, 2011. If for whatever reason the student does not attend CCS, any amount paid for tuition is fully refundable. However, the \$400 application/book fee will be forfeited.

### Quarterly plan

The amount of \$762.50 will be due June 1, Sept 1, Dec. 1 and March 1. If for whatever reason the student does not attend CCS, any amount paid for tuition is fully refundable. However, the \$400 application/book fee will be forfeited.

### Semi-Annual plan

The amount of \$1525.00 will be due on Aug. 1 and Feb. 1. If for whatever reason the student does not attend CCS, any amount paid for tuition is fully refundable. However, the \$400 application/book fee will be forfeited.

THE ENTIRE TUITION AMOUNT MUST BE PAID BY APRIL 1, 2011 IN ORDER TO RECEIVE SCHOOL CREDIT FOR THE SECOND SEMESTER.

### Multiple family discount

For families with:

- 2 or 3 students enrolled — 25% discount will be given to the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3rd child's tuition
- 4 or more students enrolled — additional 50% discount will be given to the 4<sup>th</sup> (and on) child's tuition
